HIGHLAND CHRISTIAN PRESCHOOL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

At Highland Christian Preschool we aim to create a nurturing environment while preparing your child for kindergarten.

We do our best to offer a variety of classes to meet your family's schedule.

2's and 3's Classes (Older 2's and Young 3's)

These classes are for children who miss the August cut off for the preschool classes but are ready to start school. With a small class, the teachers are able to create a nurturing environment; keeping in mind this may be their first experience being separated from their parents. The focus is geared on socialization and gaining social and emotional skills. These classes offer weekly themes, story time, ZooPhonics, free play, art projects, science exploration, fine motor skill activities and large motor activities outside on the playground. The ratio is 10:2.



3's and 4's Classes – Preschool (Older 3's young 4's)

We create a nurturing environment for your preschooler, keeping in mind this may be their first school experience. The focus is geared on socialization and gaining social and emotional skills combined with an introduction to academics to create a positive start to the school experience. These classes offer weekly themes, letter of the week, story time, phonics, writing, free play, art projects, social studies, science exploration, fine motor skill activities and large motor activity outside. The curriculums used are Play to Learn, ZooPhonics, Learning Without Tears and STEAM Education. The ratio is 16:2.

Pre-Kindergarten Classes (Ages 4s and 5s)

The Pre-K classes focus on preparing your preschooler for kindergarten not only academically, but social and emotionally with an emphasis of becoming self-confident. These classes offer weekly themes, letter of the week, story time, phonics, writing, free play, art projects, social studies, chapel, science exploration, fine motor skill activities and large motor activity outside. The curriculums used are Play to Learn, ZooPhonics, Learning Without Tears and STEAM Education. We offer a 3 hour Pre-Kindergarten class or a 4 hour Pre-Kindergarten class. In the 4 hour class, students will bring their lunch to eat at school. The maximum ratio is 16:2.

The registration fee and material fee is due at time of registration. Tuition for the last month of the year is collected at the beginning of the year for the preschool's financial security and in order for us to keep tuition down for all families. HCP does not give refunds or transfer money to other families' accounts. If you need to withdraw from the school, before the end of the school year, you may use unused fees as a donation. All tuition payments are to be made by online payment.

The last month's tuition (June 2023) is due by July 1, 2022 to guarantee your child's spot in the class. June's tuition is non-refundable and is not assignable to another month or family. You will not pay for the last month of school if you have paid consecutive months throughout the academic year.

Tuition is set depending on the financial needs of the school for the year, so each month is an equal payment adding up to the total tuition dues. As such, the school cannot afford to lower tuition for families due to illness, vacation, holidays, etc.

Tuition and reoccurring payments

- Payments are made through Tuition Express processing system.

- First tuition payment is due July 1 or at time of registration if registering after July 1.
- Payments are due monthly August 20 through April 20.
- \$50 late charge in addition to the tuition amount after the 25th.
- \$50 fee charged for returned checks (NSF fee).
- Payments are due and processed at the 20th of the month.
- Any changes to enrollment must be made by the 15th of the prior month in writing.
- If payment is not received by the 1st of the month, your child may be dropped from the class.

COVID-19 NOTICE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF STUDENT and FAMILY RISK

Each family making the decision for your student to participate in Highland Christian Preschool during the 2022-23 school year should do so after considering the risk presented by COVID-19. The **individual voluntary decision** to participate should be based on your individual health status and other personal considerations.

COVID-19 is a disease caused by a virus that can spread from person to person. Much remains unknown about the virus and we continue to learn about the disease and associated symptoms. Students who are, or have family members who are, at high risk or increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19 should consider consulting with a health care professional prior to enrolling in in-person school classes offered by Highland Christian Preschool.

Highland Christian Preschool holds as paramount the health, safety, and welfare of every member of its community. Having said that, the reality is our Program Staff cannot guarantee a COVID-19-free environment. This is simply not feasible.

Taking steps to minimize the risk of COVID-19 infections (or any other spread of disease) at any Highland Christian Preschool program is a shared responsibility. Every member of our community, including individual students and their families -- must do their part. This means adhering to national, state, and local health guidelines and requirements, and adhering to those measures Highland Christian Preschool deems safe and appropriate for its school. Specific details will be provided as circumstances dictate, but these may include measures such as: temperature checks, physical distancing, wearing cloth face coverings or other facial coverings, using other personal protective equipment, not attending school if sick, and isolating and quarantining when required.

Families must agree to do all of this not just for themselves but for the safety of others, and because this is consistent with their obligations as members of the Highland Christian Preschool community.

Families making the decision for students to participate in Highland Christian Preschool during the 2022-23 school year must understand that there are inherent risks associated with this decision that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid infection. Although the Highland Christian Preschool will be taking steps to mitigate these risks, Highland Christian Preschool cannot guarantee that students and parents will not become infected and/or infect others.

By voluntarily deciding for students to participate in Highland Christian Preschool during 2022-23, each family acknowledges their individual responsibility to comply with the following requirements (which may be modified as guidance and conditions change):

- Frequently check themselves for any symptoms of COVID-19 and maintain ongoing awareness of whether they are experiencing any symptoms;
- Notify a healthcare provider immediately and not attend Highland Christian Preschool if they
 become sick and/or exhibit any of the following symptoms of COVID-19: fever (100.4 F or higher) or
 chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, cough, fatigue, sore throat, congestion or runny
 nose, headache, muscle or body aches, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, and/or the new loss of sense
 of smell;

- Comply with the public health requirements and directives issued by Highland Christian Preschool, the City of Bellevue, the King County of Public Health, the Washington State Department of Health, other Washington state agencies, and the Washington Governor, including temperature checks, physical distancing, wearing cloth face coverings or other facial coverings, using other personal protective equipment, not attending Programs if sick, and isolating and quarantining when required;
- And understand that their decision to participate in Highland Christian Preschool during 2022-23 may result in additional costs, including healthcare costs, and additional costs of at home childcare, including, but not limited to, costs arising from isolation and guarantine.
